The celebration will feature activities and experiences for all ages, offering the first opportunity for many community members to fully explore the park's accessible pathways, gathering spaces, green areas, and recreational amenities. Local organizations, entertainment, and family-friendly activities will showcase the many ways the park is designed to bring people together while highlighting the partnerships that helped make the project possible.

The Holmes Family Park joins the city's growing system of parks and public spaces. The Main Street Park Alliance will continue supporting the long-term success of the park through the Chelsea Parks Sustainability Fund, helping ensure these community spaces remain vibrant for years to come.
